Nomination process

- Your name or name of nominee
- Telephone and email contact information for yourself and the person you're nominating
- Name and location of nominee's employer
- One two sentences about the strengths and experience of yourself or the nominee – describe your familiarity with the individual's qualification

15th of each month	Advancing and non-advancing candidates are notified of their status
Last day of month	Board candidates interviews conducted by Executive Director and two existing members
Following month	BEF notifies all candidates of their status
January/March/May/ September/November	Election of new members
